Florida Scouts Hall of Fame guidelines:

The following is a set of guidelines whereas all nominees shall have attained a majority of these criteria.

1. Nominees shall have scouted for 20 years.
2. Nominees shall have scouted in the state of Florida for a minimum of 15 years.
3. Nominees may have stayed within the scouting community although they no longer are Florida area scouts. Area scout to General Manager, director, special assistant, etc.
4. Nominees shall have resided in the state of Florida for 20 years.
5. Nominees are required to have represented scouts in a professional manner.
6. Nominees will have promoted the game and professionalism.
7. Nominees should have been an inspiration to those he dealt with in the community.
8. Nominees should have been or are a Florida Diamond Club member.
9. Nominees will have participated in Florida Diamond Club activities and assisted with FDC showcases
10. Nominees should have reached a point in their career where retirement is a possibility.
